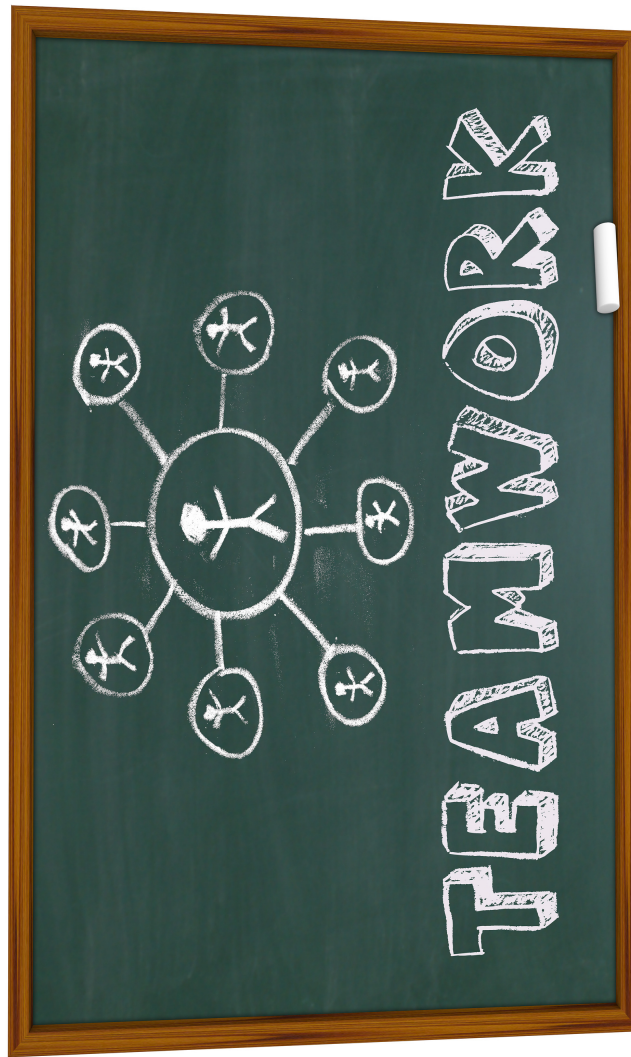

Each year the Children's Assistance for Living Committee (CALC) of TASP selects a non-profit organization for philanthropic support.
